- Exploration discussion with Siena Heights was conducted on 12/4 regarding opportunities with dual enrollment, MBA program and sustainability. Sue Gardner and Deb Coates represented KVCC in this discussion.
- Initial collaboration discussion with CMU occurred on 12/6
- University Center Student testimonial video is being completed for marketing purposes - especially increasing awareness of the program options.

## Life Enrichment

- Winter/Spring catalog is out about 60 programs have been included across the four campuses. Classes are already getting filled ... 54 registrations came in over the first weekend of posting some of the classes.
- National attention to Lifestyle Medicine, especially educational opportunities and linkages, is rapidly increasing. KVCC is well positioned to be a key driver and contributor initially through Community Culinary and Nutrition programs. Lizzie Luchsinger gave a presentation to our Instructional / Student Services administrators to begin the discussion for potential undergraduate and professional education in this field. Strong program partnerships have been established with WMed, WMCC, KCMHSAS, Bronson KZO, Bronson Battle Creek and Borgess.
- Momentum CNC academy started December 3 with a full class.
