- The Groves will be looking at a new registration system. They will be asking others from the across the college to assist with the analysis and selection process.
- The Food Innovation Center has a contract with City of Kalamazoo to support home gardeners with container gardens. Through this partnership, they provide supplies, plants and training. They are working with the City to extend funding for this to continue.
- The FIC will be hosting an open tour this Saturday, June 18th. Registration is encouraged.
- The FIC is looking for part-time workers. Referrals are welcomed.
- The Groves is working with CNM to launch a new video editing program. They will also be starting a professional readiness training for the cannabis industry.
- The college is now doing in-person orientations that include meetings with advisors.
- As of today, Kalamazoo Valley as 497 EMC students. This is a 20% increase.
- Athletics study tables have been very successful. Early enrollments for athletes have increased and several athletes have received academic honors. Abby Long has received All-American honors (achieving a 4.0 gpa) and she has been chosen to represent Kalamazoo Valley in Atlanta at the NJCAA All-Star game. She will be the first athlete to receive such an honor in 10 years.
