## 7. Updates submitted via email

- a. We are actively recruiting for Teen Battle Chef, an in-person, 8-week culinary program for high school students from both Kalamazoo and Comstock Public Schools for this free and engaging program. This program is made available to the community at no cost through a partnership with Kalamazoo Valley Community College and the Michigan Fitness Foundation.
- b. The Kalamazoo Valley Groves Campus is now an approved state testing site for Certified Nurse Assistants. The pilot program was held on March 14<sup>th</sup> and went well.
- c. Alisha Siebers and Annette Chapman will be meeting with teams across the college to share about the role of the Kalamazoo Valley Foundation in our students' success.
- d. Witness the solar eclipse at the Kalamazoo Valley Museum on Monday, April 8, 2024. A live feed from NASA and viewing assistance will be offered to help visitors understand and celebrate the much-anticipated solar eclipse. The program is free. Solar eclipse glasses are available for free until supplies run out at the museum and TTC bookstore.
- e. Sean Gordon is offering an additional Active Violence class at TTC on March 26<sup>th</sup> from 8-9:30 am in room 4370/4380
- f. All local police agencies are assisting with the Kalamazoo Area Citizens police academy. Participants will get to experience what it is like to be an officer for a day. Demonstrations of many of the activities and specialty units for the various police agencies in the county.
