Online Degree (Kathy/Fran)

The new online BUS online AAS degree was discussed. Concerns were raised about online courses and having an online degree. It was reported that the advisory committee had concerns about an online degree centering on the inability of students to communicate Face-to-Face and that they would like to hear plans to address their concern. The online degree committee was asked to develop the scope, goals and purpose or mission for the degree.

Course strategy changes

The business department approved strategy changes (adding online and/or Blended) to BUS 212 and BUS 241.

7.5 week online classes

Kathy K discussed having the online degree classes be 7.5 week courses. Concerns were raised about the desirability of this and about our students being successful at an accelerated pace. It was determined that we go slow and test the ground

Syllabi updates for Instructor Competencies

R. Kraas briefed the Department on the need to update the instructor competencies in the Syllabi to comply with HLC requirements. Example wording was shown for the two primary HLC categories: Go to work and Go to a university. The Department Okayed the chair making suggested minor changes and going ahead with modifying the syllabi in the curriculum over the summer.

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Policy for assigning classes to full time faculty
