Chair: Kim Grubka

- Kim introduced some changes made in the clinics after being back to in-person classes fall of 2022:
 - Used to require a process at the end of the semester: to clean so many teeth within a certain amount of time. Found that it was hard sometimes to find the perfect patient. We don't want to use patients that aren't appropriate. What is it telling us that we still have good results with our graduation and clinical skills?
 - New: mock boards first, second, and third clinical sessions
 - What we were doing previously with amount of calculus and amount of time, they'll have to remove calculus off a mannequin in that amount of time
 - Computerized part with three different cases that will tie in with the OSCEs they'll have to take for their licensure
 - Starting with Sam's class in 129 to experience
 - Focus on preparing students for private practice
 - When students are doing care plan and realize a patient is getting worse, have time to consult mentor
 - Hannah really enjoyed the pilot program; did not have to wait for instructors as much

- Kim spoke about implementation of policy with taking x-rays—proponent of autonomy
 - Option to say no to x-rays for 36 months, after which patient is dismissed
 - Samantha asked whether external members have similar practices
 - Jorie said there are exceptions in which she'll see patients
 - Leon said there are cases in which he can't help without x-rays; hasn't had a patient say no to x-rays
- Worked with Head Start (3, 4, 5 year olds)-education and getting teeth brushed
- Kim shared Powerpoint slide on holistic admissions
 - Healthcare experience points cannot be stacked; Kim clarified they get the highest level
 - Ben talked about strengths implementation; training students to answer certain questions
 - Katie pointed out we may lose less students through this process
 - Amy Murray stated she always recommends students do some job shadowing and get a letter; oversharing is okay

KRESA / CTE Dental Assisting – Katie Hatfield

- Currently at 6 students this semester
- 48 hour internships; she believes everyone has a placement
- Last year, everyone in a class of seven got their certificates
- Katie shared this will be her last semester teaching
- Outstanding senior every year–this year it is Carter who wants to be an orthodontist




