 - c. Greenlee hole punch kits are currently being ordered.

- 3. LaJoyce spoke about:
 - a. ELT program numbers. Approximately 40% of the 500 students are apprentices.
 - b. Apprenticeship awareness and a myth that apprentices didn't need training throughout Apprenticeship.
 - c. Apprentices cannot add/drop classes without permission from company.
- 4. Kaj asked if there was a pipeline for apprentices and how to assess them once they enter the program. Categories such as residential, commercial, and industrial along with possible climb test or other skills tests may be added. Lajoyce and Tom will look into this. It may be added into each employer's apprenticeship if requested.
- 5. ELT 224 book will use Motor Control book since it was expanded. Topics for 224 include: PLC & relays, Drives, preventive and Predictive Maintenance & ARC Flash training along with implementing the NFPA 70E Safety Book.
- 6. Tom spoke on direction of Program with emphasize on Automation & Instrumentation.
