- 4. Journeyman Prep test: There was a discussion about creating a practice test for the Apprentices to take. ELT 115 is strictly a code class, and NEC code questions are in most classes, but the discussion revolved around having the apprentices take an actual Code test before the end of their training. Tom said he would look into the KVCC Testing Center to administer it. This computer lab environment would mimic the environment and method in which the State test is administered. Hopefully, this practice test helps prepare the apprentices better with time management, test anxiety, general NEC knowledge and feedback.
