- 3. Tom explained the Curriculum changes:
 - a. General restructuring of ELT offerings. Also, rename some courses so students do not take them out of order. Did not change the course numbers.
 - b. Starting January 2021 "ELT 280 (ELT 104 starting in summer) Instrumentation 1" course will be offered on-line. Greg Meeuwsen is Instructor.
 - c. New PLC equipment (Studio 5000) for the PLC course and new 24V equipment for the Motor Control trainers. Greg Meeuwsen will be teaching both subjects.
 - d. Amatrol on-line curriculum added to three courses (ELT 220, ELT 222, and ELT 280). This replaces the need for a physical book in the course.
 - e. Five classes offered on-line: ELT 100 Basic Electricity, ELT 115 National Electrical Code, ELT 120 Electrical Machines, ELT 218 AC Drives, & ELT 280 Instrumentation. This will help with the class offerings for apprentices in case class offerings are limited because of Covid restrictions.
 - f. Restructured some electives and general education classes.
 - g. More NEC code and NFPA added to some courses.
- 4. Tracy explained:
 - a. The new Schedule starting in January because of Covid restrictions.
 - b. Futures for Frontliners Program
 - c. Perkins Funding
 - d. Nontraditional student recruiting-this was an open discussion by many members. Informing Schools, Counselors and Families about what the Trade Programs have to offer.
