6.5.1 Course Titles, Program Plan	 S. Mott shared we are submitting the new nursing curriculum proposal for approval by the advisory committee and KVCC's curriculum review board. As recommended by the advisory committee our focus is based on a more concept based curriculum. S. Mott shared the changes to the pre-requisite requirements. Group discussion followed. 	
6.5.2 Concept-Based Approach	 S. Pernie and G. Barton Beery reviewed the new curriculum content and layout of the program with the group. Much discussion followed. BSN programs are concept-based driven and ADN programs are following suite. C. Stroven shared counseling will continue to push gen-ed courses for BSN completion. Both Bronson and Borgess will be requiring a BSN within 5-6 years for new hires. Allegan does not have a BSN requirement at this time but they do offer a pay differential. Their focus is on a cultural fit. Group was supportive of the new curriculum plan.
