Topic: Reorganzation of welding program curriculum and courses in response to Advisory Committee recommendations.

- 1. Repackage existing courses into new expanded courses.
 - a. Decommission all 182,184,186,188 3 credit courses.
 - b. Decomission all 191,192 4 credit courses
 - c. Decomission all 240,255,265 advanced courses.
- Renumber basic courses to 151 GMAW/FCAW,152 GTAW,153 SMAW, increase contact time to 4 hours and focus on basics and fillet welding.
 153 SMAW increased to 3 credit hours. Must complete basic courses with a "2.0" to be able to advance to 200 level courses.
- 3. Renumber 154 Blueprint reading Welding Symbols increase contact time to 3 hours, include more measurement and layout.
- 4. Renumber 201 to Advanced GMAW/FCAW Groove weld certification testing.
- 5. Renumber 202 Advanced GTAW groove welds, weld certification.
- 6. Renumber 203 Advanced SMAW groove welds, Weld certification
- 7. Renumber 204 Welding Automation.
- 8. New degrees:
 - a. 151+201+154 = COA GMAW/FCAW 10 credits.
 - b. 152+202+154 = COA GTAW 10 credits
 - c. 153-203+154 = COA SMAW 9 credits
 - d. Certificate degree between 31-38 credits with electives.

Discussion: Soft skills – Attendance, workplace communication, enough skill set to become employed.

Build courses and present in Spring 24 to committee for approval.
