- 1. Acceptance of the Agenda

- 3. Informational Updates
 - Juamaine Douglas is new Interpretation Specialist staff member. IS Staff members staff the floor and help guide guests.
 - December numbers are slightly down; school groups didn't visit due to the closing of the Challenger Learning Center and severe weather.
 - Web visits are slightly down in December.
 - Holiday Happenings took place in the MJST over holiday break.
 - Fretboard Play-In Contest: Cosmic Knot and Sarah Lynn Band were winners. They will perform in the Fret Festival and will be contracted later for a performance.
 - Chili Cook-off on January 27 will offer vegan chili.
 - Spring Break Hands-On Happenings take place during KRESA spring break.
 - Storytelling Festival is February 2-3.
 - 13th Annual Fretboard Festival is March 2-3.
 - Foodways Symposium is April 6-7.
 - Statewide Astronomy Night is April 20.
 - FY18 projects all completed or underway except computers scheduled for replacement in office workstations and exhibits.
 - New gun storage has been installed in Collections.
 - Official opening of Innovation Gallery was December 7, 2017.
 - New office spaces have been created upstairs, and doors were installed today.
 - DEQ project in front of the KVM is complete, and plantings were done before the freeze. As an educational piece, an outdoor sign will be created, as well as a description of the rain garden in the lobby.
 - ProCo exhibit is open until Fretboard Festival.

- Hateful Things is closing January 15, has been generally well received. Dr. Michelle Johnson will be speaking about genealogy January 14.
- Guitar exhibit closed Sunday and will be shipped out this weekend to make way for Top Secret: License to Spy on January 28.
- Golden Books exhibit is opening January 27.

- Draft of Strategic Initiatives was shared; list will be sent to members when it is finalized.
- Volunteer Newsletter was shared, with opportunities to volunteer at programs this spring.

 - Museum Explorers events were not well attended, so the program was canceled, but we still email events if you give us your email on the website.
- We could send a survey out to collected email recipients.
- Many people can't get to the Museum. How could we get them here to inspire kids?
 - Museum Explorers was trying to do that, but it was unsuccessful. Our programming team will continue to look at that issue.
- Outreach to kids with small elements of exhibits could draw them here. Connecting
 with churches could help. We could have an open room for a specific topic, and
 people could bring items in—a community-based presentation or exhibit. Churches
 could help come up with an exhibit or spread info about exhibits or programs.
