- Heard a brief update on the State's budget and the funding recommendation for community colleges – this means we could receive around \$122,000 less from the State than initially budgeted.
- Noted that retention of students is especially critical in terms of financial aid KVCC must reimburse the feds when students on financial aid drop their classes – this can have a big impact on our budget.
- Reported that effective July 1, 2008 the federal mileage rate was increased to 58.5 c.
- SCH projections for FY 2009 were shared.
- Reminder on travel as soon as any Cabinet member approves travel for an employee, please inform Sue Egan in order to get the best travel rates.
- The Capital Outlay budget is still pending we will not know the outcome until later this summer. As of today, KVCC is back on the list.
- Reported on changes in the list of approved manpower for FY 2009 it was suggested that an adjunct position be allocated to I.T.
- Briefly reviewed Cabinet member vacation schedules for the next couple of weeks.
