- Higher Learning Commission

- Planning Worksheet / Strategic Issues
  - Reviewed the draft of the planning worksheet and agreed to share information with and receive input from various units throughout the College before finalizing.
  - An updated draft will be reviewed next week and shared with the Board in October.
- Academic Calendar for 2012-13 and 2013-14
  - Both academic calendars were accepted as presented.
