## **Awards**

 NACUBO Strategic Finance for Student Success Grant – Selected to be a part of a three year cohort project with \$10,000 annual stipend for participation plus \$1500 provided annually to cover travel expenses to attend NACUBO annual meeting.

This grant project is designed to bring together higher education leaders and campus-based finance leaders to develop a framework to ensure that impactful pilot projects or grant-funded initiatives are fully integrated into campus financial planning processes early, and that positive outcomes are financially and operationally sustainable. This project is specifically targeting institutions who serve at least 40% Pell-eligible students, and are leveraging Guided Pathways or Tackling Transfer practices to improve student outcomes.
