# **Update/Action Items/Presentations**

The minutes of July 18, 2017 were approved as presented.

- 1. B. Lueth presented information about Ellucian grant services. The Cabinet had a number of questions about the service, including Ellucian's long term track record of success with community college clients. As a next step, B. Lueth will ask Ellucian more about their community college track record, and ask Ellucian to visit KVCC and make a presentation about what they have to offer.
- 2. B. Lueth presented a summary of the Accelerated Study in Associate Program (A.S.A.P.) being followed by City University of New York (CUNY). The results CUNY has experienced with A.S.A.P are impressive. As a next step, a subgroup (D. Bertch, B. Lueth, K. Johnson, M. Schlack, C. Jbara, J. Nykaza) will explore the potential of a grant funded pilot project which uses the A.S.A.P. program model to encourage current students to complete, and to reengage students who have dropped out. The target date to complete an initial concept paper is August 23, 2017.
- 3. D. McCurdy presented on Culinary Program opportunities for growth, focusing on expanding in-house catering service offerings and Havermill Café, 418 Restaurant, and private dining room operating hours. The decision was taken to move forward with expanding operating hours and in-house catering options for the Culinary Allied Health Café, Restaurant, and private dining room.
