1. Call to Order – The meeting was called to order by D. Bertch at 11:00 a.m.
2. Meeting Minutes of May 20, 2016 were approved as presented.
3. Review/Revise/Approve Agenda – The June 16, 2016 agenda was approved as amended (5.5 Course Revisions – add PSY 270 Educational Psychology Teaching Assistantship to add a Blended (HY) strategy), (5.7 Program Revisions – add 5.7.6 Graphic Design Certificate).
4. Announcements/Updates – None presented.
5. Business
 - 5.1 Proposed Master Syllabus – deDie/Kraas/Fredericks – B. deDie reported S. Walman has agreed to pilot the proposed master syllabus with his Accounting classes. The group briefly discussed the pros and cons of a limited pilot recommending the pilot be extended to a broader audience. All present agreed to move forward with the recommendation to pilot with S. Walman and others to be identified by G. Fredericks.
 - 5.2 Course & Curriculum Committee Role and Purpose – D. Bertch distributed for review the revised draft Course and Curriculum Committee Role and Purpose and provided the group with an overview of the revisions to the document. After brief discussion the revised draft Course and Curriculum Role and Purpose was approved as presented. D. Bertch noted this document will be shared again with the ALC for informational purposes only.
 - 5.3 Alternative Test Levels – P. Eagan distributed for discussion and review a draft master chart for alternative test levels. P. Eagan noted information contained in the document was provided by D. Lindsley. Discussion ensued and included the following: implementing a check and balance system (accountability), the impact on departments (Counseling and Admissions), and SAT equivalencies. S. Hubbell will review and think through the recommendation of alternative test levels to determine impact and report back. D. Bertch and P. Eagan will continue to discuss.
 - 5.4 Course Inactivations
 - 5.4.1 ANM 105, Drawing Basics for New Media, 3-1-2 (Lecture/Standard Lab) – A. Rodgers discussed the recommendation to inactivate ANM 105, Drawing Basics for New Media, 3-1-2 (Lecture/Standard Lab) stating this course is duplicative with ART 103, Drawing and Composition I, 3-1-4 (Lecture/Standard Lab) and does not transfer. After brief discussion it was MOVED, SECONDED, and CARRIED to inactivate ANM 105, Drawing Basics for New Media, 3-1-2 (Lecture/Standard Lab).
 - 5.4.2 ANM 130, Intro to 3D Game Art, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) – A. Rodgers discussed the recommendation to inactivate ANM 130, Intro to 3D Game Art, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) stating aspects of this course are taught in other courses, this course has been offered but did not run and

this course does not transfer. After brief discussion it was MOVED, SECONDED, and CARRIED to inactivate ANM 130, Intro to 3D Game Art, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab).

5.4.3 ANM 181, Introduction to Interactive Media, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) – A. Rodgers discussed the recommendation to inactivate ANM 181, Introduction to Interactive Media, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) stating this course is no longer relevant due to the outdated software (Adobe Flash) used to teach the course. After brief discussion it was MOVED, SECONDED, and CARRIED to inactivate ANM 181, Introduction to Interactive Media, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab).

5.4.4 ANM 229, e-Publishing, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) – A. Rodgers discussed the recommendation to inactivate ANM 229, e-Publishing, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) stating this course is no longer relevant due to industry changes. After brief discussion it was MOVED, SECONDED, and CARRIED to inactivate ANM 229, e-Publishing, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab).

5.4.5 ANM 254, Print Production, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) – A. Rodgers discussed the recommendation to inactivate ANM 254, Print Production, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab) stating this course is no longer relevant due to industry changes. After brief discussion it was MOVED, SECONDED, and CARRIED to inactivate ANM 254, Print Production, 3-2-3 (Lecture/Standard Lab).
