- Fall NSO Updates by numbers
 - March 1st through beginning of the Fall 2021 semester, we started with anyone who identified as a new student was counted at 975 students who went through online orientation.
 - Students continued to get communication about finishing the online orientation.
 - A lot of traction on our adult/transfer student orientation. We do not have an exact number or how many finished this orientation.
 - We were able to serve our students right before the semester started by offering our “College Terms & Resources “presentation during the *Tie it Up Tuesday & Finish it Friday* events.
