1. De-Duplication
 - a. Based on researching, the way we currently identify possible duplicates, and check and merge them appears to be the most accurate
 - b. Need to explore software that can mimic this process without accidentally merging different
 - c. All forms used for adding students to Salesforce need to be updated to include more than name and email
 - i. Birthdate recommended but at least home address and mobile number
 - ii. Will help with de-duplication immensely
 - iii. Includes questionnaires, event attendance, etc.
 - d. More assistance needed to address record deduplication in the system
 - i. Sometimes hundreds of records; After large imports, 1k+
2. Enhanced Domains
 - a. Salesforce enhanced domains implementation
 - i. Meets the latest browser security standards
 - ii. Testing in Sandbox necessary
 - b. Timeline
 - i. October 2022 = enforced
 - ii. October 2023 = automatic redirects
3. Email Customization
 - a. Need for native Salesforce email customization to be implemented
 - i. 1:1 and List View mass email functions limited to personal (primary) email accounts
 1. Impacts native SF email functions as well as event reminder email
 - b. Avoid building a process that requires switching ALT and primary email values
 - i. Issues arise via applications being submitted after accounts have been created, forms that override KVCC email value, etc.
 1. FERPA implications
 - c. Recommendation for Salesforce customization to be built by third-party developer
 - i. Kennedy and Company has been consulted with in the past; start there
 - d. Potential to utilize HERF fund for this as it correlates with increased need driven by COVID
